2. ECC Programme Summary Update



Keep people well in their own homes and support them to maintain a healthy lifestyle



Provide **primary care and GP services** through multidisciplinary care planning to those with complex care needs residing in the community



Develop and provide access to **specialist services in the community to targeted groups** of people, particularly those at most risk of requiring access to unscheduled care in acute hospitals and where this could be prevented or reduced



Display how the **end to end model approach** enables the implementation of integrated care programmes and could be used for overlay of other integrated programmes and strategies e.g. paediatrics, palliative care & maternity and infant as they are developed and resources permit



Provide **services on a population basis** following assessment of those that need it, in a timely manner and local to where they live



Link with other **community services, voluntary and statutory bodies** to provide enhanced support to those who need it



Ensure that **discharge from acute hospitals is coordinated** so that people can return home to their own environment as soon as possible



Apply **resources intensively in a targeted manner to a defined population**, implementing best practice models of care to demonstrate the delivery of specific outcomes and sustainable services, which can be scaled for full national implementation

Key Priority is the establishment of

- ✓ 96 CHNs, providing the foundation and organisational structure through which integrated care is provided locally
- ✓ 30 community Integrated Care Specialist Teams for Older People
- ✓ 30 Integrated Care Specialist Teams for Chronic Disease

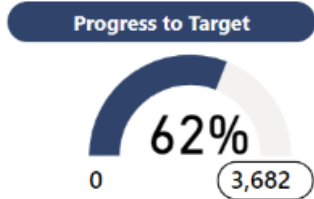

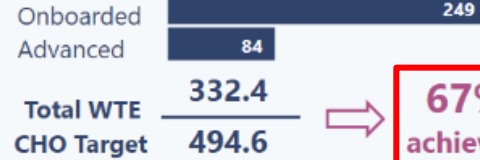
